APPLE was privileged to have Brian Parr, Special Agent in Charge of the United States Secret Service (USSS), New York Field Office, as our November luncheon guest speaker. In detailing his illustrious career and providing an overview of the elite USSS, SAIC Parr had the rapt attention of everyone in attendance as he covered a wide range of topics including the agency's dual mission of investigation and protection, and the critical task of ensuring the integrity of the nation's financial systems. He also gave first-hand insights into investigations involving the counterfeiting of U.S. and foreign obligations and securities, and current USSS protocols regarding terrorism. In regards to protection, the lecture delved into how USSS duties have expanded to not only include the president and vice president and their immediate families, but how the same package is given to the president-elect and vice president-elect; and similar protection given to visiting heads of foreign states or governments and their spouses.

Annual AAPLE Seminar:

The annual AAPLE Seminar will be held on November 24, 2008, at 6:00 pm, in the Law Office of Cadwalader, Wickersham and Taft, located at One World Financial Center, 38th floor conference room.

This year's AAPLE Seminar features Sergeant Robert Minca and Detective Paul Carlin of the NYPD's OCCB Vice Enforcement Division, Major Case, and Robert Morris, President and Co-founder of Love146.

Sergeant Robert Minca and Detective Paul Carlin will discuss the definition of Human Trafficking as defined by NYS Legislation, and cover topics that include where most victims are from and which victims are most vulnerable; who the traffickers actually are and their methods of control and coercion; and many other aspects of this crime as it pertains to the law enforcement community.

Robert Morris is the Co-Founder and President of Love146, and will lecture on his non-profit organization's work toward the abolition of child sex trafficking and exploitation through prevention and aftercare. Founded in 2002, Love146 trains aftercare workers, provides safe homes, aids socioeconomic development programs in high-risk communities, and provides a voice for victims of these horrible crimes.

The annual AAPLE Seminar is free to our members; non-members are invited to attend for \$40.00. Current members are encouraged to renew their membership at this time.
