### President's Message:

November 2009

AAPLE was privileged to have as its October luncheon guest speaker, Colonel Daniel Allen Rice, Assistant Professor of National Security Law, Environmental Law and Constitutional Military Law at West Point -the world's premier institute in leader development. Each year approximately 1,000 cadets join the *Long Gray Line*, and upon graduating 47 months later, they are commissioned as 2<sup>nd</sup> Lieutenants serving with the United States Army. During his lecture, Colonel Rice discussed how West Point develops its cadets "intellectually, physically, militarily, ethically, spiritually and socially." Additionally, he addressed how the U.S Military Academy Mission, *To educate, train, and inspire the Corps of Cadets so that each graduate is a commissioned leader of character committed to the values of Duty, Honor, Country and prepared for a career of professional excellence and service to the Nation as an officer in the United States Army*, is fulfilled.

Colonel Rice also discussed the Academic Individual Advanced Development (AIAD) program, an internship opportunity for West Point cadets who are pursuing a degree in Military Art & Science. The program offers enriching opportunities overseas and across the country that include: conducting research with Naval Postgraduate School professors on cutting-edge military issues; working personally with the National Training Center (to research Battle Commands); the FBI's Hostage Negotiation Team; and the NYPD. The Colonel also dispensed insight on the training of the Afghan National Army (ANA) by coalition forces, and its stated goal to ultimately take the lead in land-based military operations.

Colonel Rice presented a moving tribute in memory of all the men and women who gave their lives while serving in the military, including West Point graduates 1Lt. Laura Walker, 27, who was killed in action on August 18, 2005 in Delak, Afghanistan; and Lt. Jonathan W. Edds, 24, who was killed in action in Baghdad, Iraq on August 17, 2007.

At the conclusion of the lecture, all AAPLE members in attendance were afforded the opportunity to participate in a question and answer session with Colonel Rice.

Below is a preview of anticipated topics; please join us for professional insight into the development of:


- Strategic Analyses supporting CompStat and real-time deployment of police resources;
