PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

December 2010

Season's greetings and best wishes for a happy, healthy and prosperous New Year! I thank you all for your support of the organization throughout the year, and look forward to a successful 2011.

I also want to thank our November 2010 Seminar guest speaker, retired United States Air Force four-star General Michael Vincent Hayden, for graciously speaking at our event. The 41-year veteran of the Air Force spoke about his experiences serving as the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) Director; the Commanding Officer of the Air Intelligence Agency; Director of the Joint Command and Control Warfare Center; and as Deputy Chief of Staff for the United Nations.

Mr. Hayden explained that as CIA Director he was responsible for protecting the nation by: collecting information that revealed the plans, intentions and capabilities of our adversaries and provided the basis for decision and action; producing timely analysis that gave insight, warning and opportunity to the President and other decision makers charged with protecting and advancing America's interests; and conducting covert actions at the direction of the President to preempt threats and/or achieve U.S. policy objectives.

Historically speaking, Mr. Hayden also discussed how before December 2004, the CIA was the main intelligence organization of the US government and was responsible for coordinating the activities of the US Intelligence Community as a whole. However, the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004, created the office of the Director of National Intelligence (DNI) that effectively took over management and leadership of the Intelligence Community.



Mr. Hayden is the longest serving Director of the National Security Agency (1999 - 2005). From 2005-2006, he served as Principal Deputy Director of National Intelligence and from 2006-2009, as the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) Director. He is currently a principal at the Chertoff Group, and also serves as a Distinguished Visiting Professor at George Mason University School of Public Policy.
