### President's Message:

As part of the night's festivities, we will present AAPLE's highest awards, as well as select the 2010 college scholarship winners. Good luck to all scholarship candidates and congratulations to our honorees: Deputy Commissioner of Operations Patrick Timlin and Federal Reserve Chief of Operations Charley Duffy. I hope to see you all there.

Deputy Commissioner of Operations Timlin is this year's **AAPLE Law Enforcement Officer of the Year**. His experience, professionalism, and steadfast dedication to the citizens of the City of New York and the NYPD have earned him this honor. Congratulations. After retiring from the Department in 2002, at the rank of Assistant Chief, Commissioner Timlin joined the Clinton Group, an SEC investment advisor, heading their Anti-Money Laundering and Business Continuity Programs. In 2004, Commissioner Timlin brought his expertise to Michael Stapleton Associates, Ltd., a NY-based security firm that specializes in elevated threat protection and detection services worldwide. After eight years in the private sector, he returned to the NYPD to oversee the Department's Compstat program.

Chief of Operations Federal Reserve/Law Enforcement Unit Charley Duffy is this year's **Robert Colangelo Award Recipient**. His efforts to improve and revitalize our organization have earned him this honor. Congratulations. Chief of Operations Charley Duffy joined the Federal Reserve Bank of New York in December of 2000 as an Assistant Staff Director of its Protection Department. In 2003, he was promoted to Staff Director, and was given full operational responsibility of the Federal Reserve Law Enforcement Unit at the Bank's New York location. In June of 2009, he was promoted to Officer and Chief of Operations of both the New York and New Jersey offices. His duties include: monitoring daily post assignments, transportation assignments, visits of dignitaries, and performing protection related investigations. He also oversees the executive protection of key bank personnel and acts as liaison to outside law enforcement agencies including the NYPD, Port Authority and US Customs. Prior to working for the Federal Reserve, Chief Duffy served for 20 years in the NYPD. In 1992, he was promoted to Sergeant, and in 1993, he was chosen by then-Chief of Patrol Mario Selvaggi to become the Department's first city-wide coordinator of the Area Police/Private Security Liaison program. In that capacity, he interfaced with over 1,000 private security directors sharing crime, intelligence, and training information.

Our May Luncheon guest speaker was Director, INTERPOL Washington Timothy A. Williams, United States National Central Bureau (USNCB). I would like to thank him for taking the time out of his very busy schedule to speak to the membership. Director Williams discussed his responsibilities that include: acting on behalf of the Attorney General as the official representative to the International Criminal Police Organization located in Lyon, France; and directing all operations, policies, and procedures related to INTERPOL Washington. He also discussed his experiences as the Chief of Technical Operations Group (TOG) with the U.S. Marshals Service (USMS), where he worked prior to joining INTERPOL. In that capacity, he oversaw the nationwide air surveillance operations; the electronic surveillance unit; the tactical support operations; and the intelligence and analysis directorate within the Investigative Services Division. He gave a very informative speech followed by an equally informative Q & A session.
