PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

November 2010

Due to the passing of long-time friend, retired NYPD Sergeant Special Assignment John Clifford, Police Commissioner Raymond W. Kelly was unable to attend the AAPPLE luncheon as scheduled for October 12. Sergeant Clifford was last assigned to the Office of the Police Commissioner and a dedicated member of the service for more than 34 years. On behalf of the entire AAPPLE organization, I wish to extend our deepest sympathies to John's wife, Bernadette, his family and friends. He will be missed.

We hope to reschedule both Police Commissioner Raymond W. Kelly and former United States Secretary of Homeland Security Michael Chertoff in the near future. We apologize for the inconvenience.

In Police Commissioner Kelly's absence, we are grateful that the NYPD's newly appointed Deputy Commissioner, Counterterrorism, Richard Daddario, graciously accepted the invitation to speak.

Before his appointment, Commissioner Daddario most recently served as the U.S. Department of Justice attaché in Moscow, during which he provided legal counsel to the United States Embassy's executive staff, and acted as liaison to Russian law enforcement officials on issues related to terrorism, narcotics trafficking, and transnational crime. As an Assistant United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York, his dedication to justice was recognized with the prestigious *John Marshall Award for Litigation* in 2001, and the *Organized Crime and Drug Enforcement Major Case Award* in both 1998 and 2000.

In his speech, Deputy Commissioner Daddario touched upon many of the fascinating aspects inherent to overseeing the NYPD's Counterterrorism operations. The glimpses he shared into his numerous responsibilities provided the basis for valuable insight into running and coordinating the Lower Manhattan and Midtown Manhattan Security Initiatives; the Securing the Cities Initiative; the "Shield" Program (the Department's public-private security partnership); the Threat Reduction Infrastructure Protection Section; and the detectives assigned to the Joint Terrorist Task Force.

We are now lucky to have as our November 2010 Seminar guest speaker, [Michael Vincent Hayden](#), retired United States Air Force four-star general, former Director of the National Security Agency and former Director of the Central Intelligence Agency. From April 21, 2005–May 26, 2006, he was the Principal Deputy Director of National Intelligence, a position which once made him the highest-ranking military intelligence officer in the armed forces.

As the longest tenured Director in the history of the National Security Agency (1999–2005), Mr. Hayden oversaw the controversial NSA surveillance of technological communications between persons in the United States and alleged foreign terrorist groups.

In 2006, Mr. Hayden was nominated for the position of CIA Director and re-appointed to the rank of general, following the resignation of Porter J. Goss. The Senate Intelligence Committee voted 12-3 to send the nomination to the Senate floor, and it was confirmed by the United States Senate on May 26, by a vote of 78-15. With President George W. Bush in attendance, Hayden was sworn in as the Director of the Central Intelligence Agency later that month. Though Mr. Hayden retired from the Air Force after 41 years of military service in July 2008, he continued to serve as Director of the CIA until February 2009.

Currently, Mr. Hayden is a principal at the Chertoff Group, a security consultancy co-founded by former Homeland Security Secretary Michael Chertoff. Mr. Hayden also serves as a Distinguished Visiting Professor at George Mason University School of Public Policy.
