PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

SEPTEMBER 2010

The summer of 2010 was the hottest ever in New York City history. I hope you and your families were able to stay cool and enjoy the season.

Our *First Annual Fall Cigar Night* was met with inclement weather, but thanks to the spectacular roofed terrace at Battery Gardens and a generous assortment of luxury prizes, our members still had an enjoyable evening. AAPLE NYC, Inc., takes great pride in announcing POLICE COMMISSIONER RAYMOND W. KELLY as the featured speaker at our next luncheon.

Raymond W. Kelly was appointed the 41st Police Commissioner of the City of New York by Mayor Michael R. Bloomberg on January 1, 2002. He is the only person to hold the post twice, serving first as the 37th Police Commissioner from 1992-1994. Commissioner Kelly spent 31 years with the New York City Police Department and served in 25 different commands.

The former Senior Managing Director, Global Corporate Security, at Bear, Stearns & Co. Inc., Commissioner Kelly also served as Commissioner of the U.S. Customs Service. In that capacity he managed the agency's 20,000 employees and \$20 billion in annual revenue, and was later awarded the Alexander Hamilton Medal for Exceptional Service for his accomplishments.

From 1996-1998, Commissioner Kelly was Under Secretary for Enforcement at the U.S. Treasury Department. While there, he supervised the U.S. Customs Service; the U.S. Secret Service; the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms; the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center; the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network; and the Office of Foreign Assets Control.

Commissioner Kelly was also elected Vice President for the Americas of Interpol and served on the executive committee from 1996-2000. As Director of International Police Monitors in Haiti, he led a U.S. force responsible for ending human rights abuses and establishing an interim police force. For this service, Commissioner Kelly was awarded the Exceptionally Meritorious Service Commendation by the President of the United States, as well as the Commander's Medal for Public Service by the Chairman of the Joint Chief's of Staff.

A combat veteran of the Vietnam War, Commissioner Kelly retired as a Colonel from the Marine Corps Reserves after 30 years of service. He holds a BBA from Manhattan College, a JD from St. John's University School of Law, an LLM from New York University Graduate School of Law and an MPA from the Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University. He has received honorary degrees from Marist College, Manhattan College, the College of St. Rose, St. John's University and the State University of New York.
