Our April luncheon speaker will be Martin Karopkin, Esq., the New York City Police Department's Deputy Commissioner of Trials. Prior to his appointment to the NYPD in 2006, Deputy Commissioner Karopkin served as a Kings County Assistant District Attorney in the Rackets Bureau from 1972-1978; as the New York City Parks Department Inspector General from 1978-1981; and New York City Fire Department Inspector General from 1981-1986. Appointed as a New York City Criminal Court Judge in 1986, and re-appointed in 1994, he also presided as Acting Justice of the Supreme Court and Acting Judge of New York City Family Court until his retirement from the New York Courts in 2003. He then served as an International Judge with the United Nations Mission in Kosovo from January 2004 – July 2005. Deputy Commissioner Karopkin was also an Adjunct Professor of Forensic Psychology at the New York University Graduate School of Psychology. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the State University of New York at Stony Brook, and a Juris Doctor from Brooklyn Law School. He was admitted to the Bar of the State of New York in October 1972.

In his current position, Deputy Commissioner Karopkin supervises four administrative judges who, along with him, preside over NYPD disciplinary trials.

## **NOTICE TO AAPLE PAYPAL USERS**

AAPLE has cancelled the recurring, annual membership fees that were billed to your PayPal account. This was necessary because too many members appeared to forget that membership charges were automatically billed to their PayPal accounts annually, and they subsequently forwarded duplicate payments. We have reversed the charges on the duplicate payments. The notice from PayPal informing that your yearly membership dues have been canceled **does not affect your AAPLE membership**; it only cancels PayPal's membership subscription that was used to automatically collect your annual dues. Until further notice, future membership transactions via PayPal will be a one-time charge and you will be required to initiate your renewal yearly.
