Commissioner Kelly is the only person to hold the post twice. He first held the position from 1992-1994, as the 37th Police Commissioner; and is currently the 41st Police Commissioner, appointed by Mayor Michael R. Bloomberg on January 1, 2002.

After serving as the Commissioner of the U.S. Customs Service, Commissioner Kelly was Under Secretary for Enforcement at the U.S. Treasury Department from 1996-98. In that capacity he supervised their enforcement bureaus, including the U.S. Customs Service, the U.S. Secret Service, the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms, the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center, the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network, and the Office of Foreign Assets Control.

From 1996-2000, Commissioner Kelly served on the Interpol Executive Committee and was elected Vice President for the Americas of Interpol. As Director of the International Police Monitors in Haiti, he led a U.S. force responsible for ending human rights abuses and establishing an interim police force. For this service, Commissioner Kelly was awarded the Exceptionally Meritorious Service Commendation by the President of the United States and the Commander's Medal for Public Service by the Chairman of the Joint Chief's of Staff.

Commissioner Kelly is a combat veteran of the Vietnam War, and retired as Colonel from the Marine Corps Reserves after 30 years of service. He holds a BBA from Manhattan College, a JD from St. John's University School of Law, an LLM from New York University Graduate School of Law and an MPA from the Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University. He has received honorary degrees from Marist College, Manhattan College, the College of St. Rose, St. John's University and the State University of New York.
