It was good to see you all at the annual Post Holiday Party. I want to express my thanks for your support of the organization, which allows us to make meaningful donations to worthwhile charities and scholarships each year. I would also like to again thank all of our 2011 guest speakers who have extended their time and expertise to the organization: the Honorable Raymond W. Kelly, NYPD Police Commissioner; Deputy Chief Investigator Cyber & Forensic Investigation Richard Britton, Manhattan District Attorney's Office; Martin Karopkin, Esq., NYPD Deputy Commissioner of Trials; Major General Robert L. Wolf, U.S. Marine Corps; and the November Seminar speaker, Jon Alpert, Director/Producer & Co-Founder of DCTV.

We begin the 2012 luncheon series on February 14, with guest speaker Judge Michael B. Mukasey who served as the 81st Attorney General of the United States from November 2007 to January 2009. He oversaw all activities of the Justice Department, and advised on critical issues of domestic and international law. From 1988 to 2006, he served as a district judge in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, becoming Chief Judge in 2000. While on the bench, he presided over numerous cases, including the trial of Omar Abdel Rahman, the so-called "blind sheikh," and nine co-defendants, convicted of a wide-ranging conspiracy that included the 1993 bombing of the World Trade Center and a later plot to blow up New York landmarks, including the Holland and Lincoln Tunnels, the United Nations, and the FBI's New York headquarters in Lower Manhattan.
